Holt Physics Chapter 7 Rotational Motion Measuring Rotational Motion Spinning objects have rotational motion Axis of rotation is the line about which rotation occurs A point that moves around an axis undergoes circular motion (revolution)  $s = \text{arc length}$ ,  $r = \text{radius}$   $\theta = \text{angle of rotation}$  (measured in degrees or radians) corresponding to  $s = r\theta$  ( $\text{rad}$ )  $\theta = s/r$  If  $s = r$ , then  $\theta = 1$  radian If  $s = 2r$
